- because students learn better by doing

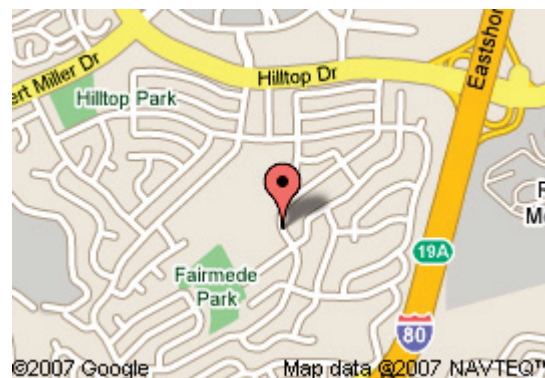
